It is the policy of the Board of Directors of Scotts Valley Water District:

To sustainably manage the groundwater supply through promoting water-efficient landscapes that are appropriate for local climate conditions.

In support of that, customers of the Scotts Valley Water District are required to comply with a 3-day per week irrigation schedule, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. All irrigation must occur before 10am and after 5pm.

This schedule applies to spray and drip (and all other low volume) irrigation when it delivers potable water for ornamental landscapes.

Recycled water may be applied any day of the week, but with the same irrigation hours as potable- 10am and after 5pm.

Failure to comply with these watering restrictions may result in fines of \$100 per calendar day (or higher for state mandates) and/or disconnection of service. Fines will be levied until the violation is sufficiently remedied per the discretion and/or inspection of the District.
